Dear Student,

Official registration for the 2010 Fall Semester courses will be held August 2-6, 2010, however, you may register any time before the official registration dates. Enclosed is information that will help you as you consider your course selections.

Students may now register online. Visit our website ([www.knoxseminary.edu](http://www.knoxseminary.edu)) and click on the “Online Registration & Grades” tab, then click on “Course Registration” and scroll down to “Find and Select Courses” and add your courses. Once your registration has been completed, I will email you a copy of your fall schedule.

Students are encouraged to meet with their advisors before registering for courses. Your academic advisor will be available, **by appointment**, to assist you as you plan your program of study and to provide you with whatever academic, vocational, and spiritual counsel you may need that he may be able to offer. You must first obtain a copy of your degree audit from me to review with your advisor.

There is a new technology fee (\$25) that all students will be charged each semester to cover the costs of things such as Wi-Fi, printing, and photocopies made in the library.

We are encouraging all students who need to be on the payment plan to sign up for automatic credit card payments. We will, however, still allow payments by other means, but you will need to give a credit card number as a guarantee for payment. If an alternate payment is not received by the due date, we will simply charge your card with the minimum balance due. You will also need to sign a new contract as part of registration. Your first payment is due when you register, or if you pre-register, the due date is the last day of registration, August 6.

Current students who register after August 6, 2010, will be charged a late registration fee of \$50.00.

**If you plan to graduate in May 2011** and you haven't already gone over your degree audit with me, please be sure to make an appointment with me before you register so we can be sure you will have all the courses you need.

### **Tuition Refund Policy**

A student who withdraws from the Seminary or from individual courses receives a tuition refund based on the following schedule:

1	100%
2	80%
3-4	60%
5-6	40%
7-8	20%
Beyond 8 weeks	none

### **Adding, Dropping, and Withdrawing from Courses or Changing Credit Status**

Students may add a course for credit, withdraw from a course, or change their status in a course from audit to credit within the first week of the semester by completing the appropriate form, available in the Registrar's Office.

Students who wish to change their status in a course from credit to audit must petition the professor and the Registrar before the ninth week of classes by completing the appropriate form, available in the Registrar's Office.

Students may withdraw from a course without academic penalty in the 1st through the 8th weeks of full-semester courses. Students who withdraw in the 2nd through the 8th weeks will receive a grade of W. Students who withdraw from a course in the 9th through the 12th weeks will receive a grade of WF (withdrew failing) but may petition the faculty in writing to change the grade to W. Petitions must include the grounds that would justify the grade change. Students who withdraw from a course in the 13th week or after will receive a grade of F.

### **Withdrawal from the Seminary**

To withdraw from the Seminary, students must submit an Official Notice of Withdrawal form to the Registrar after completing exit interviews with the Dean of Faculty, the Dean of Students, the Business Manager, and the Registrar. Refund information is found in the school catalog.

### **Accreditation**

Knox Theological Seminary is a fully accredited member of *The Association of Theological Schools in the United States and Canada*. The Association's Commission on Accrediting is recognized by the U. S. Department of Education and the Commission on Recognition of Postsecondary Accreditation for the accreditation of graduate professional theological education.

### **Authorization**

Knox Seminary is in compliance with Section 1005.(6)(f), Florida Statutes, and is therefore not under the jurisdiction or purview of the Commission for Independent Education, and is not required to obtain licensure.

The degree programs of Knox Seminary are designed solely for religious vocations.
